Preschool Class Descriptions

Pre-Wee Folks-PWF

A great first time class experience for children who are in the process of mastering toilet training but need the reassurance of pull-ups. Classroom goals will focus on social skills, following simple directions, and developing small motor skills. Children must be eager and ready to be away from a parent. Children may wear pull-up diapers, but they will not be changed by instructors during class. **Children must be 2 ½ yr. by Sept. 1, 2013.** Class Min. 10/Max. 16 JM

Wee Folks- WF

Children will explore social skills, alphabet, colors/shapes, numbers and name recognition and develop small motor skills. Students are exposed to themed learning centers, circle time, stories, and large motor skill activities. Children must be able to take care of their own bathroom needs. **Children must be 3 yrs. old by Sept. 1, 2013, toilet trained, and no pull-ups.** Class Min. 10/Max. 18. JM

Pre-K -PK

Children will develop kindergarten readiness skills and self-confidence as they are exposed to math concepts, beginning writing skills, number and letter sound recognition. Classroom curriculum is themed based using learning centers, arts & crafts, circle time, stories, singing, role playing, and large motor skill activities. Children must be able to take care of their own bathroom needs. Children bring a snack and juice to class. Children will also go on field trips. **Children must be 4 yr. old by September 1, 2013 and eligible for Kindergarten in fall of 2014.** Class Min. 10/Max. 20.JM

Preschool Registration 2013

1. Registration is accepted in-person only. Registration forms will be available at the Centre front desk.
2. First month tuition fee is due with registration form as well a copy of child's birth certificate as proof of age.
3. The IL Department of Health Medical with current immunizations is due before the first day of class.
4. Registration for classes will be ongoing based upon space available.
5. Cancellation from the program for any reason will result in a \$75 cancellation fee.
6. Families may receive a multi-child discount of 5% off the each child in program.

Preschool Payment Plans Available

Full payment fees are for the entire school year term September 2013 through May 2014. Parents have the following payment options.

1. Pay in Full plan: Full payment fee minus a 5% discount at time of registration.
2. Nine Month Payment Plan: Full payment fee is split into nine monthly payments. First payment is due at time of registration. Each monthly payment is due on the first of the month starting October 1st through May 1st.

Preschool Extended Care Available

Extended care allows parents the option to drop off or pick up their child one hour before or after their child's preschool class begins or ends. Parents are required to register at least 1 week before the care is needed. There is no extended care on Holidays or during no-school days. Fee: \$5 per day for one child for before/after care on one day and \$3 per child for either before or aftercare.
